

Maintaining school affiliation

For children in grades that are receiving public health immunization services, ensure that the children have an occupation of "student" and that the **current** school is selected under Organization Name. This will ensure that the children's immunization information will be reflected on school based reports. It will also enable you to add multiple students to a Mass Immunization Event Worksheet easily.

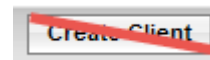

Documenting neonate high risk for hep B to trigger the forecaster

For children with a low birth weight (less than 2,000 grams), the required fourth dose of hepatitis B vaccine can be forecasted in Panorama if "Low Birth Weight – Under 2,000 grams" is entered as a risk factor. Use Quick Reference Card 1.13 to ensure that you document the low birth weight as a risk factor correctly.

Create Client function

It is important that you **do not use** the Create Client function in Panorama.



All client records should flow to Panorama from the Client Registry system. If you need to document an immunization on a client, but cannot find the client in Panorama, contact your regional super user or Panorama trainer for direction.
