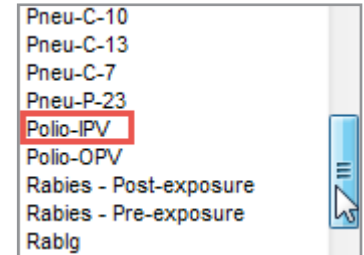

### Documenting unspecified polio

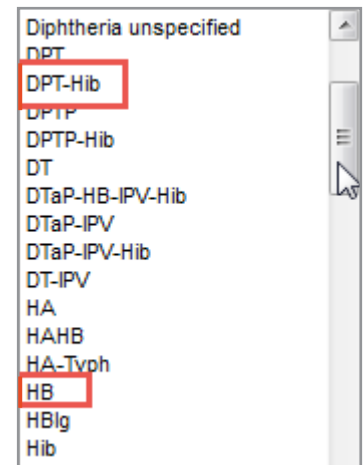
When documenting historical polio immunizations, the options available are Polio-OPV or Polio-IPV. If a paper immunization record does not specify OPV or IPV, it is most likely IPV as only a few countries administer the oral polio vaccine. If unknown, select IPV because there is no "unspecified" option in Panorama.



### Documenting vaccines not in the drop down menu

There may be a few vaccines/agents that are not in the immunizing agent drop down menu. If you cannot find the agent in the drop down menu, enter the agent as an **individual** antigen or group of antigens. This allows the forecaster to appropriately forecast the next immunization date.

**Example:** If DTwPHibHepB was provided to the client in Cameroon, it should be entered into Panorama as DPT-Hib & HB



### Multi-site vaccines

When recording an immunization that was administered in multiple sites, enter the immunization as one immunization, document the site as **Other** and in the Comments section, record the sites that were used and the specific dosage or volume administered at each site.

### Consent for influenza vaccine in a mass immunization event

When consent is granted for influenza in a mass immunization event, consent will automatically be granted for all the influenza vaccines/products listed in that mass immunization event. This occurs because consent is based on antigen, not agent/product.

**Example:** The mass immunization event includes both trivalent and intranasal influenza. Once consent is documented for trivalent, the mass immunization worksheet will indicate that consent is granted for both trivalent and intranasal.
