
Adverse Events following Immunizations (AEFI)

Adverse Events following Immunizations (AEFI) continued:

Regions can begin entering new AEFIs into Panorama directly once users have viewed the training video. Please check with your region for transition plans and new processes for documenting AEFI's in Panorama.

We have worked closely with the MHSAL Surveillance Unit to update the AEFI form to facilitate data entry into Panorama.

The new form and updated user guide is posted on the MHSAL website:

MHSAL has communicated this change to all immunization service providers.

Completed AEFIs on immunizations administered prior to January 2017 will be entered by MHSAL, if not already in Panorama. Any AEFIs from vaccines administered on or after January 1, 2017 will be the responsibility of the regions to enter.

After January 1, if AEFI reports are faxed to MHSAL instead of the region, MHSAL will enter the minimum data to create an AEFI record, and then fax the report to the regions for the remaining entry into Panorama and completion of recommendations.

If any regions have issues with these time frames please contact MHSAL.

Thanks to all who participated and provided feedback in the Panorama AEFI process.

Do not forget to throw out any old unused AEFI forms! Please email the Service desk with any concerns.

Inventory Reminder:

Panorama was implemented not only as a new system for documenting, forecasting and tracking of immunizations but also to increase the visibility of inventory and reduce wastage across the regions and across the province as a whole.

It is the responsibility of each region to ensure that individual Public Health Offices are completing monthly cycle counts, ensuring that immunizations are entered into the system in a timely manner as well as ensuring that expired vaccine is removed from Operational Holding Point Locations and returned to the Provincial Vaccine Warehouse as soon as possible for cost recovery.
