**Re:** **Cadham to PHIMS Interface Go Live Reminder – July 16, 2020**

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This is a reminder that the Cadham Provincial Lab (CPL) to PHIMS Interface is going live **tomorrow (July 16, 2020)**.

**NOTE:** All Public Health reportable CPL lab results will be delayed on the first day (Thursday July 16, 2020). CPL lab results will start to be available in PHIMS by approximately **2:00 p.m. on July 16, 2020** for processing by the regions.

Going forward, regions must use the Lab Workload Report to obtain new lab results for diseases managed in PHIMS. For diseases not managed in PHIMS, MHSU will fax the PHIMS “Received Reports” to each region.

Attached with this memo is the presentation from the CPL-PHIMS Interface information sessions that were offered to help regions prepare for this change. This presentation steps through the processes, identifies which QRCs to follow, and provides instructions for reassigning cases/contacts to another region (see slides 13-18).
