Effective tomorrow, Thursday May 6, 2021, PHIMS will offer additional features for managing inventory.

## What does this mean for me?


When you login to PHIMS you will see that Manitoba Pharmacy is no longer an option. Instead, you will see the pharmacy where you are located. Having your pharmacy as the organization allows you to see what inventory is left in PHIMS.

Join a free online PHIMS orientation session webinar to view live demonstration in PHIMS and have your questions answered on PHIMS use. Sessions are held multiple times per week and are available to all pharmacy users.

#### If you are a PHIMS user working at multiple locations:

When you log into PHIMS at a new location, ensure you have chosen the correct Pharmacy as your Organization. *You must still set the immunization defaults every time you change locations*. Remember that incomplete or incorrect set-up can negatively impact your inventory counts and associated billing.
