Effective June 5, 2021, **the Public Health Information Management System (PHIMS) will be updated to** include the following improvements and defect fixes for the following screens:

- Investigation Quick Entry (IQE)
- Exposure Quick Entry (EQE)
- Exposure Summary
- o Maintain Transmission Event
