


Investigations:

Immunization History Interpretation - Create

QRC

Ensure client and investigation are in context



Points to Remember:

- The choices listed in the Disease dropdown list are filtered by the Encounter Group of the disease under investigation. For example, if a Hepatitis B investigation was created in the Sexually Transmitted and Blood-borne Infections (STBBI) encounter group, other STBBIs will show in the dropdown list.
- Click Cancel to return to the Immunization History Interpretation Summary page if the incorrect Disease was selected.
- The immunization history interpretation will be associated with the investigation when the interpretation is entered while an investigation is in context.
- Interpretation Date defaults to current date. If no other date is specified, leave as current date.
- Hepatitis B immunization history interpretation is only mandatory for Hepatitis B investigations. However, public health nurses will routinely review immunization histories with all clients and may complete the immunization history interpretation section.

Footnote:

The Disease dropdown list asks you to select the *vaccine-preventable disease* that has been interpreted, which may not be the disease being investigated. For example, a Hepatitis B immunization history interpretation may have been done as part of a syphilis investigation, while a mumps immunization history would be done for a mumps investigation. Note that the Immunization History Interpretation on the STBBI Case Form relates to Hepatitis B immunization.



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
