When receiving a Non-Nominal or an Anonymous Lab Report from Cadham.

The Client's "**Last Name**" and "**Alternate ID**" will be a code. That code is only known to the ordering provider and/or the client.

Consult with your supervisor. This client's lab report will need to be entered manually.

Communicable Disease Management Protocol (HIV/AIDS) February 2010

The attending health professional must complete the *Manitoba Health Case Investigation Form for Nominal & Non-Nominal Positive Cases* and /or the *Manitoba Health, Seniors and Active Living HIV Case Report Form for Anonymous Testing* and submit it to Manitoba Health.

* Non-nominal testing: the HIV test is ordered using a code of the person being tested. Only the person ordering the test knows the identity of the person being tested and is able to link the result to that person's health care record.

* Anonymous testing: the HIV test is ordered using a unique non-identifying code. The person(s) ordering the test and providing the result do not know the identity of the person being tested. Only the person being tested knows the code, so the test result is not linked to that person's health care record.
