



### Points to Remember:

- Prior to 2012, MIMS records were archived when clients had been out of the province for more than 2 years. Since all clients in the Manitoba Insured Benefits Registry were included in PHIMS, clients with archived records will be found in a client search in PHIMS, but will not have any associated immunization records, or may be missing immunization records from the past if they have recently been immunized in Manitoba.
- This report is generated when a client/immunization provider is seeking immunization records that may have been archived in MIMS.
- A blank Archive Immunization Record indicates that there are no archived immunization records for this client.
- If the client cannot be found in PHIMS, this indicates that there are no archived immunization records for this client.
- PHIMS users should add historical immunizations in the client immunization record in PHIMS for clients that have returned to Manitoba and are no longer 'inactive' in PHIMS.
- MB6799 Archive Immunization Record ONLY includes the immunization history. It does not validate immunizations, nor is the 'Next Immunizations Due' information included in the report. If this information is required, or the client is now active and living in Manitoba, the immunizations must be entered into PHIMS in order to access the forecast information.
