



# Immunizations: Reason for Immunization Definitions

## Reason for Immunization for COVID-19 definitions

Reason for immunization	Definition
Community with disproportionate disease impact	Individuals eligible for vaccine by being a member of a community identified as a priority population based on disease impact in the community.
Congregate living, other	Individuals living, volunteering or visiting in a group setting such as a long-term care facility, hospital, assisted living residence, group home, shelter, correctional facility, etc. Excludes personal care home residents, but can include personal care home essential visitors or other non-health care staff.
Personal Care Home resident	Individuals residing in a personal care home.
Occupational hazard (e.g. HCW)	Health care workers providing direct care within an acute care facility, personal care home, long-term care facility, community, correctional facility.
Routine (age-based indication)	Individuals who are eligible for vaccine based on age.
