


Points to Remember:



Points to Remember:

- The search will perform only on the most recently entered (current) disposition.
- Dispositions can be future dated.
- Both disposition and disposition date can be updated at any time by any user via the 'Investigation Information' page



Points to Remember:

- Use the [Advanced Search](#) hyperlink to access additional search parameters.
- Search parameters are optional. Enter specific parameters to refine your search or remove parameters to expand your search.

Footnotes:

- 1 Enter a date range to search only those investigations that have a **Report Date Received** within that date range.
- 2 Select Disposition to search for investigations with a specific disposition (such as *pending*).
- 3 Status indicates whether an investigation is *open* or *closed*
- 4 The Investigator Organization represents the region assigned to the investigation. This may be: FNIH, Interlake-Eastern Health, Northern Health, Prairie Mountain Health, Southern Health - Santé Sud, Winnipeg Health (including Churchill), Correctional Service Canada, Out of Province
- 5 The Investigator Workgroup drop list is populated by the selection of the Investigator Organization.
- 6 Investigator drop list is populated by the selection of the Investigator Workgroup and will contain a list of users associated with the selected workgroup.
