RE: **STI Treatment Information Available in eChart Manitoba**

A new paper-based [Manitoba Health Provider Report Form for Sexually Transmitted and Blood-Borne Infections \(STBBI\) and STI treatment](#) was implemented in early December 2022 to support information sharing between health-care providers and Public Health. The Provider Report Forms are uploaded into PHIMS and any STI medications listed on the Provider Report Forms are entered into PHIMS.

An interface has been developed between PHIMS and eChart to improve treatment information sharing. Effective March 2, 2023, STI medication information entered into PHIMS will be transferred to eChart and viewable by health-care providers.
