

Immunization Details

Inventory 'Left Hand Nav' – Changes

- Most of the Left Hand Nav is the same, and links take you to the same pages
- The only changes are in the 'Returns'. In 2.5.7, each type of Product Return is simply a sub-category of 'Returns'. In 3.2.3 there are larger headings of 'Product Returns to HP', 'Product Return to Supplier' and 'Product Returns From External' with subcategories



Reports

The Reports landing pages have a different look and feel, though the reports themselves are the same


1. 'View Report Status' and 'View Report History' are now at the top of the table for all reports. You would still double-click on the report to open it, but if you want to see the Report Status and History, you would click the radial button and then click one of the buttons.

Reports changes

1. To return to a previous page, you will not use a cancel button anymore. You will use the 'Return' button instead.
2. Instead of 'Clear', you will use a 'Reset' button to remove the entered data and restore the default value in Reports
3. Language setting dropdowns don't appear when the only option is 'English'

HPL In Sequence (Inventory Replenishment)

- Previously, HPLs were out of sequence when receiving product
- The Holding Point Location was previously a drop-down menu
- It is now a type ahead field
